What a difficult journey this young man has been on! Since our Thuchila Hope Center staff quy, Francis, discovered him at his home, critically ill and even unable to walk nearly two months ago, Evance has been battling to regain his health and strength, thankfully, with the help of some of the best doctors in Malawi. Initially, they found it was a serious infection that was weakening him and inhibiting his ability to digest food and even breathe properly. After intensive treatment in the hospital for nearly a week, he was released with his systems all functioning, only to return a few days later because of severe hip pain. At that point, it was discovered that the infection had actually been coming from his hip bone, a more challenging situation than had originally been diagnosed. As a result, he was transferred to Beit Cure, a first world international hospital that treats children suffering from orthopedic problems, with no charge. We are so very thankful for this amazing charity as Evance's bills over the past months have grown huge, as you can well imagine. The doctors have now done a biopsy of the area of concern and in 2 weeks, we will know the results. Updates will be forthcoming in the next newsletter. Thank you for praying with us that God will complete Evance's healing and that soon he will be back at school with his friends!
